Response: 75% (140 homes)

1. Do you want the facilities ie shop, school and recreation ground, mentioned in the Consultation document?	Yes / No 16% / 84%
2. Do you want the facilities mentioned in the Consultation document at the cost of 1400 houses?	Yes / No 5% / 95%
3. Would you want large scale development(s) or organic growth around the parish which compliments the current village, for example 500 houses as a mixture of small sites?	Large 3% Organic 96%
4. Is maintaining the strategic gap between communities important to you?	Yes / No 99% / 1%
5. If you had to choose between losing the strategic gap between Boorley Green and Botley, or, Boorley Green and Hedge End, which would you prefer to retain?	Botley-Boorley Green gap 21% Hedge End-Boorley Green gap 79%
6. Do you use the golf course for recreational activities?	Yes / No 62% / 38%
7. If there is no alternative to development would you regard it as important that housing is not built on high grade agricultural land?	Yes / No 93% / 7%
